### 1. Addressing the Diseases

**Achievement 1: 3DF works**

- ✓ 45 % of ART in Myanmar, 65 % of Malaria response, 34 % of HIV response, 29% of TB response. Diseases contained
- ✓ Round III, made possible with additional funding, shows Donors' trust that 3DF achieves results
- ✓ Myanmar application to GFATM demonstrates trust among a broad range of actors that results can be achieved in Myanmar
- ✓ New interventions like LIFT- build on 3DF model

### 1. Addressing the Diseases

**Challenge 1: Further scaling up**

- ✓ To reduce priority disease burden. Malaria incidence estimates increased considerably
- ✓ GFATM, 3DF to effectively address the public needs on a sufficient scale. More Donors welcome!

### 2. Focusing on Results

**Achievement 2: Focus on results**

- ✓ Funding must be used effectively- Concrete results for poor people is what counts
- ✓ Robust system for monitoring progress is sharpened and approved
- ✓ Reporting includes baselines, national indicators and quality data collection

**Challenge 2: Full compliance**

- ✓ Analysis and action based on national and added indicators

### 3. A Partnership

**Achievement 3: Broad and trusted partnership and network**

- ✓ Close cooperation between the fund, MOH, National programmes, INGO, UN, local NGO and the private sector
- ✓ Broad agreement with TSG on priorities for Round III
- ✓ Regular dialogue with all implementing partners
- ✓ Problem solving attitude among all partners

#### Challenge 3: Sustain good communication

- √ Sustain and improve close cooperation and communication among all key actors

#### Good progress made:

- √ Commodity and resource tracking

#### Requires more work:

- √ Data collection, compilation and analysis
- √ Fund Flow Mechanism and direct support to township level
- √ Timely requisitions for procurement
